Adoption of the Town Tax Levy at Special Town Meeting of the Electors

WHEREAS, s. 60.10(1)(A) of the Wis. Statutes authorizes the town electors of a town to adopt the town tax levy at a town meeting of the electors, and

WHEREAS, a special town meeting of the electors has been called for this 1st day of November, 2021, and

NOW THEREFORE, the special town meeting of the Town of Sherman, Sheboygan County, Wisconsin, by a majority vote of the eligible electors duly assembled and voting resolves and orders as follows:


BE IT RESOLVED, the town electors of the Town of Sherman, Sheboygan County, Wisconsin, hereby adopt the town tax levy for 2021 to be collected in 2022 at \$ 401,263.

The town clerk shall properly post this resolution in three places as required by law under s. 60.80 of Wis. Statutes within 30 days of the below noted adoption date.
