Where Do I Pay My Taxes?

To pay your **first** installment tax payments (due by Jan. 31, 2015):

- In person, at clerk's office during regular business hours and on Saturday, December 27 from 9 am to Noon.
- **By mail**. PO Box 88, Adell. If you would like a receipt, you must enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope.
- At National Exchange Bank & Trust in Adell, during regular business hours or use night drop-box. If you would like a receipt, you must enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope.

To pay your **second** installment tax payments (due July 31, 2015):

- By mail to the county treasurer's office. Address is printed on your tax bill. If you would like a receipt, you must enclose a selfaddressed stamped envelope.
- In person, at the county treasurer's office.

Please do not send your second installment to the town clerk's office. This will only delay a timely payment because it has to then forwarded on to the county via USPS mail. Thank you for your cooperation! �

Diggers Hotline - Call 811 or 1-800-242-8511 or www.diggershotline.com BEFORE YOU DIG. This service is free of charge. The Hotline is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days per year.

Disposal of Sharps - Recommended disposal options are to re-sheathe sharps and contact your local doctor, clinic, pharmacy, hospital or public health department for information on sharps collection stations. You may dispose of the sharps in rigid puncture-resistant containers with secure lids or caps, such as heavy plastic laundry detergent or bleach containers with screw caps. Please label these containers "SHARPS" DO NOT RECYCLE, and dispose of them at a collection station. These containers SHOULD NOT BE PLACED WITH YOUR HOUSEHOLD TRASH OR RECYCLABLES.

Dog Licenses - Dog licenses expire December 31 of each year. Licenses obtained after March 31 will be charged a \$10 late fee in addition to the license fee of \$6 for neutered or spayed dogs and \$13 for unneutered or unsprayed dogs. You **MUST** bring in a rabies certificate in order to obtain a dog license. REMEMBER: as a pet owner you have the responsibility to license, have vaccinated, and keep control and pick-up after your pet. Failure to do any of the above is a violation of State and Local laws and is subject to fines.

Election Forms – If you need to register to vote, or apply for an absentee ballot for an upcoming election, DO NOT WAIT! Contact the clerk at 994-9421 or download those forms from the website. Click on "Election Information".

Most <u>Electronics</u> MAY NOT be put in the trash. E-Cycle Wisconsin helps you find a place to recycle your old electronics. Google "E-Cycle Wisconsin" for details. <u>Notary Service</u> is available to Town residents during regular office hours. Bring your Driver's License along to verify your signature and do not sign the document ahead of time.

Public Notices - Agendas are posted at National Exchange Bank & Trust in Adell, at the Silver Creek Fire Hall (front of building), and at MSM Mobil on STH 57 at least 24 hours in advance of the meeting. The Sounder is the official newspaper of the Town of Sherman.
