Culvert Ordinance & Driveway Permit Application

Section 16.01 - Culvert and driveway required.

No person shall, by means of any vehicle, enter or exit, or cause any other person to enter or exit, any adjoining parcel or property from or onto any highway in the Town unless a culvert and gravel driveway have been provided for said parcel or property and except where a culvert or driveway has been determined to be unnecessary by the Town Official.

Section 16.02 - Permits required.

No person shall construct, install, repair, maintain, or reconstruct any culvert or driveway on town roads without first obtaining permits for such culvert or driveway from the Town, the fees for which shall be established by the Town Board. Such permit shall be issued in a timely manner using a form provided by the Town. Permits for county and/or state highways must be obtained from either the Sheboygan County Highway Department or Wisconsin Department of Transportation.

Section 16.03 – Permit Period.

The Driveway Construction Permit is effective for 12 months from the date of issuance. Driveways not completed by this time must have a new permit to continue construction.

Section 16.04 – Driveway Inspection.

The holder of the Driveway Construction Permit shall notify a Town Supervisor within 30 days of completion of the construction. Within 30 days of notification, a Town Road Supervisor shall conduct an inspection of the driveway to ensure full compliance with all of the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 16.05 - Specifications for constructions of new driveways, temporary culverts and temporary driveways:

A. <u>Culverts</u>: Culvert materials are restricted to corrugated steel, and Corrugated Polyethylene Pip (HDPE), meeting AASHTO M 294, Type S Specifications, at least 15

inches in diameter at the ditch line where the driveway meets the public or private road, unless modified by the Road Supervisor. The culvert length and type will be determined by the Road Supervisor.

- B. <u>Juncture with Public Road</u>: A length of driveway a minimum of 24 feet shall have a maximum of 5% slope at the point where the driveway enters onto a highway or private road. A slight dip (6 inches lower than the road surface) across the drive shall be placed just before the culvert at the entrance to a public highway or private road to prevent water and debris from washing onto the public highway or private road.
- C. <u>Drainage</u>: Ditches along the right-of-way, roadway crowning, and culverts shall be provided by the property owner for acceptable drainage. Property owners are responsible for the maintenance of culverts, which must be also kept clean and free of debris at all times. The driveway shall be planned, constructed, and maintained in a manner that prevents diversion of surface water onto the public road and the lands of other persons.
- D. <u>Costs</u>: All costs of construction of said driveway, including the cost of culverts and Driveway Plan, if required, shall be paid by the owner requesting the permit.
- E. <u>Joint Driveways</u>: Joint driveways will not be permitted without prior review and specific approval by the Town Board of the legally recorded Joint Driveway Agreement establishing the proposed joint driveway and the manner of its construction, maintenance and use.
- F. <u>General Design</u>: A driveway shall be such width and so located that all such driveway is within the limits of the public highway or private road fronting on the property served. Driveways shall not provide direct ingress or egress to or from any street intersection area and shall not encroach upon or occupy areas of the public highway required for effective traffic control or for street signs or signals. A driveway shall be located and constructed so that vehicles approaching or using it shall have adequate sight distance along the public highway or private road as determined by the zoning Administrator. Driveway approaches shall be at least twenty (20) feet apart and there shall be at least ten (10) feet from the edge of the driveway to the property line except by special permission from the Town Board, and driveways shall in all cases be placed wherever possible as not to interfere with utilities in place.
- G. <u>Temporary culverts and driveways</u>: Temporary culverts and temporary driveways are permissible for construction purposes; provided, however, that permits shall be obtained from the Town prior to commencement of such construction. Any such temporary culvert or temporary driveway must be removed and replaced with a permeant covert or driveway constructed in accordance with this chapter prior to the issuance of an occupancy, zoning, or use permit for the building or structure located upon the parcel or property served by such culvert or driveway.

Section 16.06 - Existing Driveways; Hazardous Conditions

When washing or other conditions created by existing driveways or field roads obstruct or become a potential hazard to a public highway or private road, the Town Board shall notify the property owner of the conditions. Any property owner failing to correct such condition within 30 days after notice by the town Board shall be subject to the penalties described in the penalty section of this ordinance.

Section 16.07 - Violations and penalties; enforcement.

Any person who violates this chapter shall pay a forfeiture in an amount equal to twice the fee required for the culvert or driveway permit and, further, shall remove, alter, reconstruct or correct the culvert or driveway as ordered by the Town. If the person does not remedy such violation as and within the time ordered by the Town, the Town may, in addition to any other methods of enforcement, including injunctive relief and revocation any permits, engage qualified contractors to remedy such violation, and the expense thereof shall be chard to such person as a special assessment after notice and hearing, or otherwise collect such forfeiture as provided by law. Any permits issued in conflict with the provision of this chapter shall be null and void.
